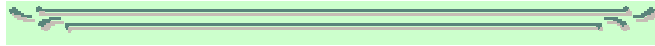

National Director's Report

The 2011 FMCA Governing Board meeting was held August 11, 2011. This is an election year, but there were a few other points of business to discuss. There were several minor changes to Policies & Procedures, as well as an announcement of a new program called the "Campground Connection". There is to be a campaign to enroll campground owners as Commercial Members, & there will be a Google map on the FMCA website to help Members to find a campground.

The Governing Board voted to authorize Executive Director Brad Koshland to explore liquidation options of the adjacent Clough Pike property, & to look into leasing the FMCA building on Clough Pike.

A new data system called Elan was approved to continue to be fully developed & implemented. This will connect all the aspects of FMCA, such as Member Services, Mail Forwarding, etc. into one system.

The Board was asked to approve holding the 2013 Winter Convention in Pomona, CA. By a very close margin, it was voted down, despite the fact that the deposit made by FMCA for the cancelled 2012 Pomona convention will be lost.

It was approved to hold the 2013 summer convention in Hutchinson, KS. This convention will be a celebration

of FMCA's 50th Anniversary, "Mile Marker 50". *Members are asked to submit ideas about a mascot & artwork for a logo.*

In an effort to contribute to saving money, the national directors voted to dispense with their \$160 travel reimbursement for 2012.

During the election of officers, Charlie Shrenkel was elected National President; Allen Rein was elected National Senior Vice President, Vicky Ferrari, National Secretary, & Wil Young, National Treasurer.
